Carry sufficient tools, spares and recovery equipment.

Fellow Road Users

Abide to the traffic rules.

Drive defensively and set an example to others.

Be friendly and courteous to fellow road users.

Assist fellow four-wheel drivers in need.

Responsibility

Take responsibility for your actions.

Promote the safe and responsible use of four-wheel drive vehicles.

Accept responsibility for your group.

Clubs

Support four wheel driving as a responsible and legitimate recreational activity.

Obey the constitution and rules of your club.

Responsible "Off-Road" Driving

Keep to existing roads and tracks. Avoid sensitive Eco systems.

Travel in a group or with other vehicles in remote areas. Take adequate water, food, first aid and fuel.

Pre-plan trips carefully before departure.

Abide to Code of Conduct:
